

EYES	Rinse immediately with plenty of water, also under the eyelids, for at least 15 minutes. Remove contact lenses and continue flushing. Immediate medical attention is required.
INHALATION	Move person to fresh air. If breathing is irregular or stopped, administer artificial respiration. Keep patient warm and at rest. Call a physician or Poison Control Centre immediately.
INGESTION	If swallowed seek medical advice immediately and show container or label. Do NOT induce vomiting.

STORAGE PROCEDURES

No special storage conditions required.
Keep containers closed tightly in a dry, cool and well-ventilated place.
Keep out of reach of children
Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs
Physically and chemically stable for at least two years when stored in the original unopened sales container at ambient temperatures.

SPILLAGE PROCEDURES

Contain Spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations

PRECAUTIONS IN USE

Use when a dry period of at least 6 hours is forecast
For use on unwanted vegetation
Do not breath spray/mist.
Do not dispose of into water courses, sinks, toilets. Dispose of as hazardous waste.

ACTIVITY	POTENTIAL RISKS	CONTROLS
Storing/Transporting	Possibility of spillage when in transit between clients/sites	Chemical kept in sealed container. Staff are trained in clearing spillage
Applying chemical	Contact could be made with spray during application	PPE to be worn during application
Spillage of liquid	Spillage of liquid may occur while handling container.	Storage procedures of herbicide approved. Spillage to be absorbed with inert absorbent material, for which disposal is approved.
