PRECAUTIONS IN USE

Wash hands after use and before eating, drinking or smoking. Keep in original container.

ACTIVITY	POTENTIAL RISKS	CONTROLS
Storing Transporting Non Toxic Blocks	Possibility of spillage when in transit between clients/sites	Non toxic
Laying Non Toxic Blocks	Possibility that Leptospirosis present in bait station	Gloves to be worn. Hands are washed with soap and water after handling, all staff trained in this procedure.
Spillage of non toxic blocks	Spillage may be possible while 'baiting' a site.	Non toxic
Access gained to non-target species	Mammals or birds may gain access to the rodenticide.	Non toxic
Cleaning Rodent boxes	Rodenticide may be handled when cleaning the bait boxes.	Wear correct PPE. Waste bait then taken to office for approved disposal.

Summary

- Sakarati Monitoring Wax is non toxic. Should an animal ingest the paste no harm will come to it.
- Technicians when laying the non toxic bait will wear protective gloves mainly for protection against rodent borne disease.
